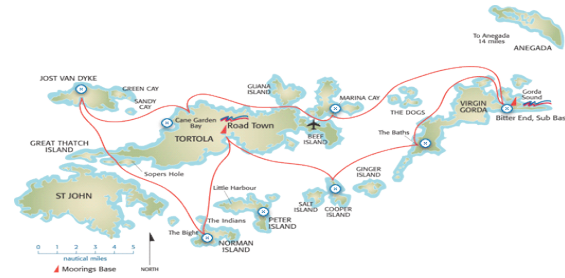


British Virgin Islands Instructional Vacation ASA 104, 105, & 114



May 21 - 28, 2009

Get three ASA certifications on this one week course in the British Virgin Islands. ASA 104, Bareboat Chartering, ASA 114 Catamaran Certification and ASA 105 Coastal Navigation courses are all included. We will be using 46-47 foot catamarans. There will be up to eight students on board and one instructor. We will visit eight islands, have fun at night and learn intermediate and advanced skills at one of the most beautiful sailing destinations in the world.



Thursday, May 21: Arrive in Tortola, relax by the pool and do chart briefing and checkout on the Catamaran. We'll settle in on the boat, and have dinner at the Mariner Inn.

Friday, May 22: Have breakfast on shore, do cruise planning, shop for provisions, then we set sail this morning for Norman Island. We'll pick up a mooring at the "Caves" for awesome snorkeling and exploring, then overnight at "The Bight". We'll enjoy dinner and dancing tonight on the Pirate Ship, "Willy T's".

Saturday, May 23: This morning we practice our navigation skills and sail over to the Indians, pick up a mooring and enjoy excellent snorkeling. We continue on to Peter Island and anchor at the most beautiful beach in the Virgin Islands, Dead Man's Bay. We'll practice beaching the dinghy, then relax and explore on this lovely beach. This afternoon we pick up a mooring at Manchioneel Bay, Cooper Island. We can dinghy over to Cistern Point for excellent snorkeling. Best sunset photography here, cocktail party tonight aboard

Sunday, May 24: We set sail to weather this morning for "The Baths" on Virgin Gorda". We'll pick up a mooring, and then enjoy fabulous snorkeling and exploring in and around the huge boulder caverns. After lunch we sail to the Bitter End on Virgin Gorda. We will anchor at Saba Rock, and then have dinner ashore at the "Pub"

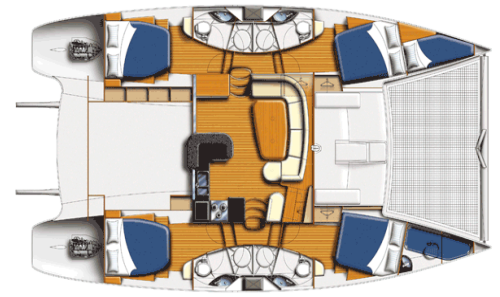
Monday, May 25: We go on a "Real Sail" today to Jost Van Dyke. We'll pick up a mooring at Diamond Cay, hike up to the "bubbly pool", then take the boat over to Great Harbour and practice our anchoring skills. Tonight, we'll have dinner and do some dancing at "Foxy's".

Tuesday, May 26: We'll set sail and anchor at Sandy Cay, enjoy a hike around this tiny island, then continue on to Cane Garden Bay, Tortola navigating the entrance carefully, then do our final anchoring and check out the sights on shore. Tonight we'll eat on shore and one of the beachfront restaurants.

Wednesday, May 27: We head out this morning for Sopers Hole, Tortola, enjoy the shops on shore, then continue up the coast to Road Town. At the dock, we'll complete our final testing, and then relax at the pool with a cold drink. We'll take the dinghy across the basin for our final dinner on shore.

Thursday, May 28: Today, we take the bus to the airport and fly home. This is the way to learn! Sure beats working!

BOAT: We using 46-47 foot catamarans. the boat has four double cabins, four heads and additional sleeping areas in the main salon. We take up to eight people plus the ASA certified captain/instructor.

COSTS: \$1695 per person includes boat fee per person, boat insurance, instruction fee, all study materials, textbooks and all test fees for ASA 104, 114 and 105. Not included is airfare (currently \$626) and provisioning; split among crew and approx \$125 per person, taxi fare to and from the airport (should run \$25 per person round trip). Students and guests pay for their own food and drink on shore and splits the cost of food on board.
