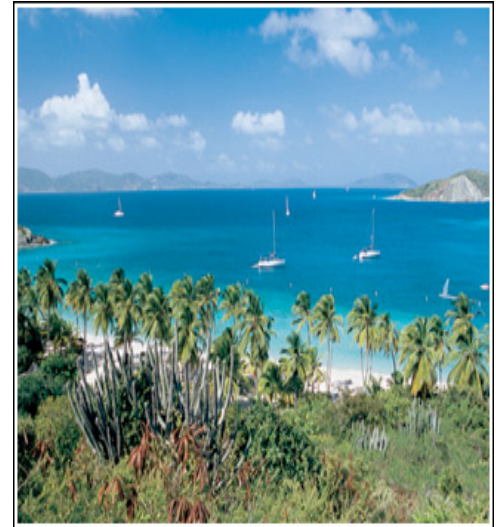
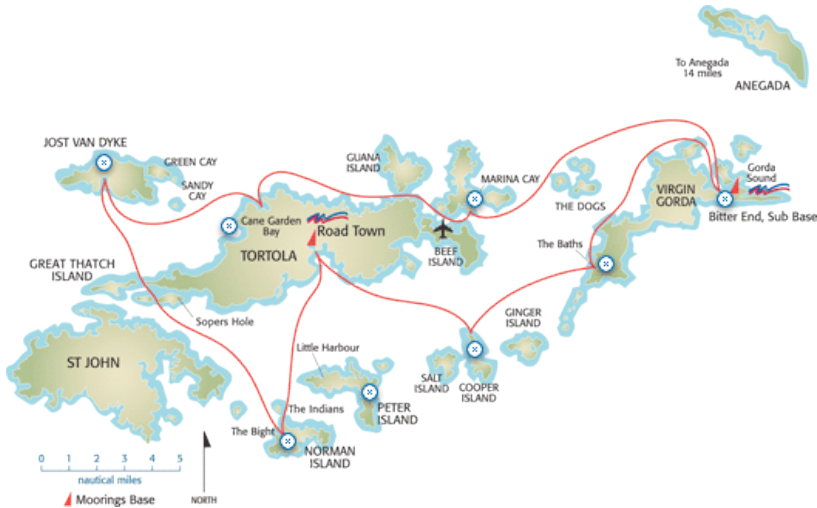


# MARINA SAILING'S VIRGIN ISLANDS SAILING VACATION MAY 21-28, 2009



**Thursday, May 22** Arrive in Tortola, relax and enjoy the pool and board our 46' Catamaran at 4pm. Dinner tonight at a local restaurant.

**Friday, May 22:** Have breakfast ashore, and then the guys attend the skippers meeting at 9am. Girls set out for shopping. Load up the boat, get the swim fins from the Moorings, and then depart the dock at noon for Norman Island. Stop at the caves for awesome snorkeling and exploring, then overnight at "The Bight". We enjoy dinner and dancing tonight on the Pirate Ship, "Willy T's".

**Saturday, May 23:** Sail over to Peter Island and anchor at the most beautiful beach in the Virgin Islands, Dead Man's Bay. Have a drink or cheeseburger in paradise at the beach bar and then wander over to Peter Island Yacht club for great views and shopping at the boutique. Later, we sail over to Manchioneel Bay on Cooper Island and enjoy great snorkeling on Cistern Point. The Beach Bar makes good "Pain Killers". Best Sunset pictures are taken right from the boat. Tonight we can eat at the Cooper Island Beach Club.

**Sunday, May 24:** This morning, we head over to the Bath's on Virgin Gorda. There is fun exploring in the caverns and pools and excellent snorkeling on the way back to the boat. We then head over to Marina. This wonderful island has a very picturesque hotel and a Pusser's Rum Restaurant and store filled with tropical and nautical clothing and gifts. There is excellent snorkeling and turtles in the bay. The hilltop bar offers great views, and live entertainment at happy hour. If you must stay connected, there is an internet café and free WIFI. Let's eat at Pusser's Restaurant tonight!

**Monday, May 25:** After breakfast, we head North Sound and pick up a mooring at the Bitter End. We can take the beautiful walking trails to Biras Creek and see some beautiful sights and cool off with a cold drink at the Bar overlooking the world. We'll have dinner on board tonight and dancing afterwards at Saba Rock.

**Tuesday, May 26:** We sail on a broad reach to Jost Van Dyke. Continue over to White's Bay and have lunch ashore and visit the "Soggy Dollar Bar" where the pain killer drink was invented. You have to swim ashore, so that is why the name of the bar. Later we'll anchor in Great Harbour and have dinner at Foxy's Restaurant tonight.

**Wednesday, May 27:** This morning, we head over to Diamond Caye and explore the bubbling pools, a natural pool surrounded by rocks at the ocean's edge. At high tide, waves tumble in through the holes in the rocks creating a bubbling salt water pool. Later we'll head over to Sandy Caye and enjoy a fun hike around the most photographed island in the Caribbean. We'll continue on to Road Town, have cocktails by the pool, and then take the dinghy to a fun restaurant.

**Thursday, May 28:** This morning, we catch our flights home.
